

Notice of intention to apply for liquor licence or a licence authorisation

Proposes to apply to Liquor & Gaming NSW for:

Description of proposed liquor-related activities:

The proposed Licencee is Louise Riles, business partner of Queen St Eatery, and local resident. The proposed addition of a Primary Service Authorisation, is in addition to a pending liquor licence application APP APP0002905231. This authorisation would allow the sale/supply of liquor for consumption on the licensed premises other than with, or ancillary to, another product or service. The venue will cater for a total of XX persons, XX seated inside, and XX outside, (on private property which part of the premises). Customers are anticipated to be both local and visitors to the area. The business will operate in strict accordance with mandated measures in the responsible service of alcohol. Such measures include mandatory training on RSA measures for all staff, and compliance with in-store RSA house policy.

Proposed activities to be provided:

The sale of liquor to be consumed on-premise, in addition to food. Range of alcoholic products will include wine, beer, cider, spirits, cocktails and ready-to-drink products, along with an offering of non-alcoholic drinks and waters. The **Primary Service Authorisation (PSA)** application will be lodged pending a month long community consultation period and subsequent lodgement of Community Impact Statement

Proposed trading hours: 8am to 11:00pm Monday - Saturday and 8:00am to 10:00pm Sunday, *subject to approval.*
